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Management Discussion & Analysis (H1 FY26) VVIP Infratech Limited

Overview

VVIP Infratech Limited is a Class "A" civil and electrical contractor with over two decades of experience in executing water, wastewater, electrification and civil infrastructure projects, complemented by a growing real estate development business through its subsidiary Vibhor Vaibhay Infrahome Pvt. Ltd. (VVIHPL). The Company operates largely across Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, NCR and adjoining northern markets, with a strong track record in sewage treatment plants (STPs), sewerage networks, water supply Infrastructure Projects and electrical distribution projects.

The real estate business focuses on mid-income residential projects under the VVIP brand, including ongoing developments such as VVIP Namah on the Delhi-Meerut Expressway and VVIP Addresses in Greater Noida West, along with an upcoming project at the Yamuna Expressway.

H1 FY26 reflects steady revenue growth on a consolidated basis, driven by the infrastructure business, alongside normalisation of profitability in the real estate segment from a strong base in FY25. The Company continues to prioritise disciplined project execution, strengthening of its order book and prudent capital allocation in a working-capital-intensive sector.

Standalone Performance (Infrastructure Business)

The standalone financials represent VVIP's core infrastructure EPC operations, covering STPs, sewerage networks, water supply projects, electrical distribution and allied civil works.

Revenue & EBITDA

Standalone Revenue from Operations for H1 FY26 was ₹1,299.21 Mn, up 17.6% from ₹1,104.36 Mn in H1 FY25, driven by healthy execution across Infrastructure Projects, STPs and electrical distribution works. The Company continued to benefit from a strong opening order book and robust tendering activity in its focus

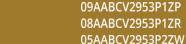
Compared to H2 FY25 revenue of ₹1,666.14 Mn, H1 FY26 revenue was lower by 22.0%, reflecting the usual seasonality in government project execution and site conditions (including monsoon-related disruptions) as well as the timing of billing milestones.

Standalone EBITDA for H1 FY26 stood at ₹216.73 Mn, registering a strong 33.1% YoY growth over ₹162.87 Mn in H1 FY25. EBITDA margin expanded to 16.7% from 14.7% in the corresponding period last year, aided by:

- better execution efficiencies in ongoing projects.
- improved mix towards higher-margin water and wastewater contracts, and
- operating leverage on a larger revenue base.

Sequentially, EBITDA was lower than ₹237.54 Mn in H2 FY25, in line with lower revenue, but EBITDA margin (16.7% in H1 FY26 vs. 14.3% in H2 FY25) continued to show an improving trend.

Profitability

Depreciation for H1 FY26 was ₹7.22 Mn (vs. ₹4.69 Mn in H1 FY25), reflecting higher capitalisation of equipment and assets. Finance cost increased to ₹30.88 Mn from ₹24.92 Mn in the prior-year period due to higher utilisation of working-capital limits in a bank-guarantee-intensive business. Other income, primarily interest and ancillary income, was ₹10.30 Mn versus ₹6.46 Mn in H1 FY25.

As a result, Profit Before Tax increased to ₹188.93 Mn in H1 FY26 from ₹139.72 Mn in H1 FY25. Profit After Tax stood at ₹136.75 Mn, up 34.1% from ₹101.98 Mn in H1 FY25. PAT margin improved to 10.5% from 9.2% in the corresponding period, and compared well with 9.6% in H2 FY25, underlining the structural improvement in profitability of the infrastructure segment.

Business & Operational Highlights

Robust Order Book and Pipeline

The Company continues to maintain a healthy order book across STP & sewerage, water supply and electrical distribution, providing multi-year revenue visibility. As of Sept 2025, the infrastructure order book stood at approximately ₹13.8 billion, with outstanding value of around ₹8.1 billion across construction and 0&M contracts.

VVIP remains an active participant in tenders under central and state programmes such as Namami Gange, Jal Jeevan Mission and AMRUT 2.0, RDSS Scheme of Electrical all of which are backed by long-term government spending on water and wastewater infrastructure.

Execution Across Key Verticals

Water & Wastewater (STP & Sewerage):

VVIP has built a strong niche in STPs based on SBR technology and sewerage networks, with projects across Etawah, Kasganj, Shahjahanpur, Mathura and Ghaziabad, complemented by long-term O&M contracts that provide annuity-like revenue visibility.

• Water Supply (Jal Jeevan Mission):

The Company continues to execute large rural water supply schemes in districts such as Rampur, Farrukhabad and Kasganj, which involve both construction and 10-year 0&M responsibilities. These projects leverage VVIP's engineering capability while deepening its presence in core states.

• Electrical Distribution:

VVIP remains a preferred contractor for utilities in Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand for distribution network strengthening, feeder separation and loss-reduction projects in locations such as Meerut, Roorkee, Moradabad and Baghpat.

Real Estate Business

Through its subsidiary VVIHPL, the Company is developing residential projects under the VVIP brand:

- **VVIP Namah (Ghaziabad):** a mid-income residential project located on the Delhi–Meerut Expressway, with \sim 300 flats and strong sales traction.
- **VVIP Addresses (Greater Noida West):** expanding the brand's presence in established micromarkets.
- **Upcoming Yamuna Expressway project:** a ~10 lakh sq. ft residential development on a 20,235 sq. m land parcel acquired via YEIDA e-auction, with projected gross revenue of about ₹8,000 Mn and a four-year execution timeline post launch.

Revenue recognition from real estate remains milestone-based, with revenues and margins booked after achieving 25% physical and financial progress, leading to inherent lumpiness between periods.

Consolidated Performance (Infrastructure + Real Estate)

Revenue & EBITDA

Consolidated Revenue from Operations for H1 FY26 stood at ₹1,932.40 Mn, registering a growth of 13.1% year-on-year versus ₹1,709.21 Mn in H1 FY25. Growth was primarily led by higher execution in the infrastructure business and continued, albeit lumpy, revenue recognition from real estate projects.

Consolidated EBITDA was ₹400.78 Mn in H1 FY26 versus ₹427.85 Mn in H1 FY25, a decline of 6.3% year-on-year. EBITDA margin moderated to 20.7% from 25.0% in the corresponding period last year, mainly due to a normalisation of exceptionally high margins in the real estate business seen in FY25.

On a sequential basis, EBITDA increased by 13.6% over ₹352.85 Mn in H2 FY25, with margins improving from 17.7% to 20.7%, driven by better operating leverage and improved mix in the infrastructure business.

Adjusted EBITDA (post minority interest) came in at ₹344.91 Mn in H1 FY26, compared to ₹337.46 Mn in H1 FY25 and ₹327.55 Mn in H2 FY25. Adjusted EBITDA margin stood at 17.8% versus 19.7% last year and 16.4% in H2 FY25, reflecting steady underlying profitability after accounting for the minority interest in real estate projects.

Profitability

Depreciation and amortisation for H1 FY26 was \$11.10 Mn, higher than \$7.76 Mn in H1 FY25, in line with additions to the asset base. Finance cost increased to \$32.88 Mn (vs. \$27.10 Mn in H1 FY25), reflecting higher utilisation of working-capital lines and term facilities to support ongoing projects and land-related payments in the real estate business. Other income stood at \$14.80 Mn versus \$9.81 Mn in the previous year.

Profit Before Tax (PBT) for H1 FY26 was ₹371.60 Mn versus ₹402.80 Mn in H1 FY25. Profit After Tax (reported PAT) stood at ₹253.62 Mn versus ₹275.35 Mn, a decline of 7.9% year-on-year.

After adjusting for minority interest, **Adjusted PAT (post minority interest)** increased to ₹182.87 Mn in H1 FY26 from ₹175.16 Mn in H1 FY25, registering a growth of 4.4%. On a sequential basis, Adjusted PAT was broadly stable versus ₹185.84 Mn in H2 FY25. The

Adjusted PAT margin (post minority interest) stood at 9.5% in H1 FY26 compared to 10.2% in H1 FY25 and 9.3% in H2 FY25.

Overall, consolidated performance in H1 FY26 demonstrates healthy top-line growth and resilient profitability, even as the mix between infrastructure and real estate normalised from the unusually strong base of FY25.

Capital Allocation, Working Capital & Governance

The Company operates in a bank-guarantee and working-capital-intensive environment. Management continues to focus on:

- maintaining adequate bank-guarantee, non-fund-based limits, to support a larger tender pipeline,
- tightening project-level milestone tracking to align execution, billing and collections, and
- retaining a high proportion of earnings to fund growth while deferring dividend decisions until scale is meaningfully higher.

A generational transition is underway, with the next generation of promoters and a professional management team taking on greater operational responsibilities, under the guidance of the founding leadership. The focus remains on governance, disciplined bidding within execution capacity and building a scalable organizational structure.

Outlook

VVIP enters H2 FY26 with a healthy infrastructure order book, strong tender pipeline and a maturing real estate portfolio. Government emphasis on water, wastewater and distribution infrastructure, along with continued budgetary support under flagship schemes, provides a favourable demand backdrop for the Company's core capabilities.

Management remains focused on:

- sustaining double-digit revenue growth at the standalone level in the range of 25%-30% for FY26,
- maintaining healthy EBITDA margins through disciplined project selection, cost control and operating leverage in infrastructure,
- unlocking value from existing real estate projects while progressing the upcoming Yamuna Expressway development, and
- strengthening working-capital discipline and balance sheet resilience in a growing but capital-intensive business.

While near-term profitability may continue to reflect the timing of real estate revenue recognition and project phasing in infrastructure, the Company believes that its strong execution track record, order book visibility and diversified presence across infrastructure and real estate position it well to deliver sustainable value creation for shareholders over the medium term.
